CASCADE LAKE 4-H CAMP HISTORY

In January 1965 a group of visionaries, understanding the importance of camping as a valuable learning experience for youth joined together to create the current Cascade Lake 4-H Camp. They made a request to the Bureau of Reclamation to obtain land on Cascade Reservoir. The original lease request was only for 24 acres. Each of the counties in the District and Malheur Co

were given a quota, based on population, to raise funds to start building the camp. Promotional events to encourage donation were held throughout the District. The decision was made if a person or organization builds a complete cabin they would have their name on the cabin. Next time your at camp, check above the door to see donor plaques. Construction began in August. Donations came in

from the counties and businesses. A loan was secured from FHA.

The original bid for the lodge was \$16,000-\$22,000. Camper cabins were budgeted at \$2000 each. By Jan. 1966, \$21,875 had been

raised. Camps were scheduled to begin in July. By August 1966, 1856 people had used the camp. Campers slept in tents that year. A Camp Dedication was scheduled for Sept. 10. Check the picture below for attire at the event.
