“Campaign 2010” Update

Fundraising Campaign to Raise Money for Camp Improvements and Future Needs

Last October, the Cascade Lake 4-H Camp Board announced the launch of ‘Campaign 2010’. Our goal is to fund current camp improvement needs and to build a reserve to help finish other projects by the end of the year 2010. Our goal is to raise over \$200,000 in three years through a combination of grants, corporate support, and individual contributions. Details of improvement needs are listed on our camp website.

We wanted to take this opportunity to report the success of the last year. Many 4-H clubs, individuals, businesses, camping groups have sent donations. We raised \$1710 through the ‘Stampeding for 4-H Camp’ event, received a \$5000 grant from the John & Orah Brandt Foundation, and \$6122 in donations was made from individuals, clubs and businesses. To date we have raised about \$13,000 towards our goal.

Thanks to everyone that showed their support. We appreciate all of you and all we have received. We do have more to do to be able to make all the improvements needed at camp.

The camp website was re-launched last year with a feature that allows people to make donations to the camp online. We encourage all current and former 4-H’ers to continue to donate whatever they can, whether it is \$5 or \$500 on the website. You can also send your check with the form in this newsletter.

There is also a new way for you to contribute to the Camp. If you are a donor to the **United Way Campaign**, you may direct all or a portion of your 2008-2009 contribution to the Camp’s Campaign 2010 goals. Simply specify Cascade Lake 4-H Camp’s 501(c)3 nonprofit number of **82-0262849** on your **2009 United Way** pledge form. Many employers

match employees’ donations to the United Way. Please be sure to notify them of your donation.

We encourage all of the 4-H clubs whose members have utilized the camp in the past to check out the new website and make whatever contribution you can – whether it is in the form of a financial contribution or volunteering your time to help with camp improvements. The website also has the latest news about camp, registration forms, and you can even email a camper while they are at camp next summer. Organizers of Campaign 2010 will be reaching out to clubs and individuals over the next year to discuss the project and encourage support.
